Prune & groom plants as needed throughout the season as instructed.

Recognize and report any plant problems to Nursery Manager or Retail Supervisor

Be familiar with and perform daily watering/irrigation as instructed.

Weed container & field grow areas as instructed.

Weeding & grooming of demonstration gardens and nursery areas as required.

Assist with the unloading and loading of trucks and trailers.

Tools, Equipment & Supplies Responsibilities

Know the proper use and general maintenance of nursery tools and equipment.
